### A SESSIONS:

Basic Learn-by-doing for 3-5 years,  
pre-kindergarten  
Class Time: 9:00-11:30

**A1** June 10 - July 11,  
5 weeks: 9 days (no classes July 3-4)  
Mon./Wed. OR Tues./Thurs.

**A2** July 15-25,  
2 weeks: Mon-Thurs.

**A3** July 29 - August 8,  
2 weeks: Mon-Thurs.

**A4** August 12 - 22,  
2 weeks: Mon-Thurs.

### B SESSION:

Basic Learn-by-doing for 3-5 years,  
pre-kindergarten  
Class Time: 1:00-3:30

**B:** July 15 - 26,  
9 days: Mon-Thur. (1<sup>st</sup> week)  
Mon-Fri (2<sup>nd</sup> week)

### C SESSIONS:

Adult and child learn-together classes,  
30 months through 4 years  
Class Time: 9:00-11:30  
5 Friday mornings

**C1:** June 14, 21, 28, (no class July 5)  
July 12 and 19.

**C2:** July 26, Aug 2, 9, 16 and 23.

## AFTERNOON SCHOOL-AGE CLASSES 1:00-3:30, Monday - Friday, 1 Week Sessions

*All school-age classes include basic farm activities as well as the special areas of interest described below.*

### For Children Completing Kindergarten-2nd Grade

**SCIENCE:** *Each day a special focus with hands-on science projects related to the farm.* **June 17-21  
June 24-28**

**ART on the Farm:** *Outdoor art lessons – paint, clay, pastels, “seeing and doing.”* **June 10-14  
July 8-12  
August 12-16**

**COOKING:** *Cooking with natural grains and farm produce. Learn the fun of making things yourself from scratch; eat your own work.* **July 29-August 2  
August 5-9  
August 12-16**

**WOODWORKING on the Farm:** *Learn to measure, saw, and pound. Bring home your own project and creations.* **June 17-21  
July 8-12**

**NATURE STUDY:** *Explore the surrounding woods, meadows and ponds. Discover the wonder of the natural world!* **July 15-19  
August 5-9**

### For Children Completing 1st-3rd grade

**Young Actors:** *Work and play with animals, then act and sing about all those great farm stories, even making up a few of your own farm based plays.* **June 24-28**

### For Children Completing 3rd-4th grade

**History on the farm:** *Use tools of old time farmers and pioneers to care for animals and prepare food. Discover how Native Americans lived off the land and what was here before people arrived.* **July 22-26  
July 29-August 2**

**Spanish on the farm:** *Real farm experiences add meaning to Spanish words and songs. An active learning group makes a foreign language come alive.* **June 10-14**
